

Northallerton Camera Club - Club Competitions 2019 - 2020

The club has five Members Night Competitions from this season on, three of which have a specified 'subject', plus a competition based on the four Outings held the previous summer. These competitions allow a maximum entry of three Projected Digital Images (PDI's) and/or three Prints per member.

In addition, there is one Inter-Club competition with Stokesley Photo Society, for which members can submit a maximum of two PDI's and/or two Prints. Our club entry of 15 Prints and 15 PDI's is selected from this pool of images, trying to ensure that each member has at least one image selected in each section to represent the club if possible.

A competition for Audio/Visual Presentations was introduced in 2016, with the AV Trophy being awarded to the winner. Details are included below.

- 23 Sep 2019** **Members Night 'Open' – Hand-in.**
The subject content is free, with no restrictions.
- 14 Oct 2019** **Members Night Judging – 'Open'.**
- 21 Oct 2019** **Members Night 'Motion' - Hand-in.**
Images should demonstrate a feeling or impression of motion in or around the main subject
- 28 Oct 2019** **Summer Outings - Hand-in.**
Three images from at least two different venues from this year's Summer Outings.
- 4 Nov 2019** **Members Night 'Around our County' – Hand-in.**
The images must have been taken within the **County of North Yorkshire.**
- 11 Nov 2019** **Members Night Judging – 'Motion'.**
- 18 Nov 2019** **Summer Outings Competition Judging (McCombie Metcalfe Trophy/Roebuck Trophy).**
- 2 Dec 2019** **Members Night Judging - 'Around our County'.**
- 16 Dec 2019** **A.V. Competition – Hand-in.**
- 6 Jan 2020** **A.V. Competition – to be judged by the audience. See details below.**
- 6 Jan 2020** **Members Night 'Urban' - Hand-in.**
The images should clearly have been taken in an Urban environment – see guidance below.
- 13 Jan 2020** Hand in PDI's and Prints (colour & mono) for the **NCPF Club Championships:** - Up to six of each.
- 27 Jan 2020** **Members Night Judging – 'Urban'.**
- 3 Feb 2020** **Members Night 'Open Theme' (Millennium Trophy) - Hand-in.**
Three images which must represent a theme chosen by the entrant. The images will be judged as a group and will be presented in the order stated by the entrant.
- 10 Feb 2020** Hand in PDI's and Prints (colour & mono) for the **NCPF Annual Competitions:** Up to three of each.
- 17 Feb 2020** **Stokesley PS Interclub Competition - Hand-in.**
Two Prints and/or two PDI's images of any subject.
- 24 Feb 2020** **Members Night Judging - 'Open Theme' (Millennium Trophy).**
- 12 Mar 2020** **Stokesley PS Interclub Competition:** Thursday evening at Stokesley

All Members Night Entries are presented to the Judge in a random. The whole entry is marked out of 30, regardless of Class, and the intention is that only one image will score 30 marks. Commendeds and Highly Commendeds will be awarded at the judge's discretion, regardless of Class.

NB Please keep Titles reasonably brief, with a maximum of 40 characters including spaces!

Prints

Prints should be on mounts not greater than 500 x 400mm. and must show only the Title on the reverse side, orientated to match the image. Please do not put your name on the print. It also helps if they are submitted in a carrier bag, which should be marked with the entrant's name.

AV Trophy

This is a Competition for short Audio Visual presentations:

Only 1 entry per member

Entries to be sent in advance of the night (On stick or CD)
See programme for handing in date

No entries will be accepted on the judging night of the competition

An AV shall be no longer than 4 minutes (owing to time constraints)

The AV Presentation must not show the name of the entrant

All the AV's will be scored by the audience on the judging night to determine the winner (scoring cards will be provided on the night)

The highest scoring AV will be awarded the AV Trophy
(to be presented at the Annual Dinner)

In the event of a tie the Audience will select a winner by a show of hands

Please note that the Club's Annual Exhibitions are explained in separate documents which are available later in the season, and these are organised by the club's Exhibition Secretary.
