Annual Exhibition Prints

Hand in No later than Monday 2nd March 2026

Hi All

The closing date for handing in for the Annual Exhibition Prints is 2nd March 2026.

I will be at Camera Club meetings most evenings.

You can enter up to **6** prints.

Only one mark from a section counts (as before), with your top 4 marks counting and the 2 lowest marks dropped for the “Photographer of the Year” totals.

If you are aiming for the “Photographer of the Year” it is best to enter 4 separate sections, then you have four scores towards your total, if you enter 2 images in one section then only the highest score adds to your total from that section, you lose the other image score altogether, which makes a big impact on your overall total for the year.

If you are not aiming for the “Photographer of the Year” then you can enter as you wish depending on your class.

The prints themselves can be any size, but the mounts should be no bigger than 50cm x 40cm (20 inches by 16 inches).

Some external competitions require the mount to be 50cm x 40cm (20 inches by 16 inches) and may reject any smaller mounts.

The title should be printed on the back of the print, but no name should be shown.

Print entries should be handed in at a club night and be in a bag and accompanied by the entry form, paper copies of the entry form can be downloaded from the attached files in Word format & PDF format, also available from Northallerton Camera Club website.

Please also see rules for the Annual Exhibition on the website.

All prints will be kept after the judging night, for the use of them in local show exhibitions in the summer etc, the prints will be available to be collected from the club following the start of the new season in September, thanks.
